RULES

There will be 6 classes as follows:

Class 1	White /Dry	Class 4	Red /Dry
Class 2	White /Medium Sweet	Class 5	Red /Medium Sweet
Class 3	White /Sweet	Class 6	Red /Sweet

- RULE 1. There will be no entrance fee.
- RULE 2. All persons attending the Congress, except those mentioned in Rule 6, will be allowed to compete.
- RULE 3. All wines other than Red (e.g. yellow, golden, green, tawny, pink tinted etc.,) will be classed as White. Each person will be allowed to enter 1 bottle in each class only.
- RULE 4. All wines for competition must be in standard punted clear wine bottles (26 $\frac{2}{3}$ ozs.) No halves or any other type of bottle, whether used for wine or otherwise will be permitted.
- RULE 5. All wines entered must bear a plain label giving the name of the wine in block letters also the year and state if sweet or dry. No other mark or printing must appear on either bottle or label.
- RULE 6. No judge will be allowed to enter this competition.
- RULE 7. No competitor will be allowed in the judging room while judging is in progress.
- RULE 8. All entry forms giving number of classes for competition to be returned by Saturday 11th May 1959.
- RULE 9. All wines to be delivered by 11 a.m. at the Congress on Whit Monday 18th May. No wines will be accepted after 11 a.m.
- RULE 10. The competition organisers will be the sole arbiters of any question governing the interpretation of the Rules.
- RULE 11. The decision of the Judges will be final.
- RULE 12. The fact of entry in this competition implies acceptance of these Rules.
- RULE 13. No bottle may be collected by competitors before 7 p.m.
